

LAND ACQUISITION COLLECTOR'S MESSAGE

Dasu Hydropower Project, no doubt, is a mega and vital project in Pakistan. I believe it will prove as fate changer in Pakistan. Although, its progress has been slow over the past couple of years and I believe there were solid grounds for it. Kohistan is a non-settled district with no land records. The project involves approximately 90,000 kanals of land acquisition meaning that the same number of kanals will be first recorded while keeping in view the rules and regulations of land and revenue which by itself is a long and time-consuming process. The establishment of a full-fledged land acquisition unit in Deputy Commissioner Kohistan Upper office and an office of Mr. Zia Ur Rehman, Land a dedicated land acquisition collector are indeed the measures which will force the land acquisition process to get momentum. I am pretty much hopeful that we will achieve the target with a dedicated team consisting of personnel from DC office Kohistan Upper, DHC and WAPDA.

ESTABLISHMENT OF BASIC HEALTH CLINIC



The management of Dasu HPP tries its level best to establish good working relationship with local community and other stakeholders. Such relations are established through many of the confidence building measures. Establishment of Basic health clinic is one of such measures which has been established by WAPDA in Dasu town alongside KKH. It is a primary health care unit and ideally it has to have a Male and a Female doctor, one technician and two nurses as well as basic free medicines.

DOCUMENTARY IN THE MAKING

Communication section under SR&E Unit has started working on the production of two documentaries. One is based on the baseline of the project and the other on the current project progress. The media house has collected all the relevant data from the project area spending a two weeks time and work on the production of documentaries is in progress. These doumentaries will be available for watch for watching by the stakeholders and general public at large.

CONSULTATIVE WORKSHOP

For the first time on any mega project in Pakistan, a detailed study for the preparation of Ecological & Biodiversity Management Plans has been carried out for Dasu HPP through international consultants and key experts in different fields. As a part of the study and plans, eight consultative workshops were arranged at Dasu, Besham & Islamabad. DHPP management, officers from relevant sections, community representatives from the project area as well as officials and officers from line departments of KP have participated in these consultative workshops.

They have produced a special volume (Vol. VII) for the management of these cultural and historical sites which is part of detailed ecological and biodiversity management plan for Dasu HPP.

PROJECT PROJECTION IN MEDIA

CONTRACT FOR E&M WORK SIGNED

WAPDA has signed a contract worth Rs. 52.5 billion with a joint venture of GE Hydro China and Power China Zhongnan Engineering Corporation for electro-mechanical works of Dasu Hydropower Project (Stage-I). The contract includes design, supply and installation of six francis turbines, generators, main transformers, generator and station service switchgear along with related equipment. DHPP GM/PD Anwar ul Haque and GE Deputy General Manager —the authorized representative of GE-PC JV-Aijun Xu signed the contract on behalf of their organizations. French Ambassador, Chinese and the US diplomats, Water Resources Federal Secretary Muhammad Ashraf and WAPDA Chairman Lt Gen(R) Muzammil Hussain also attended the event.

COMMUNITY CONFIDENCE BUILDING MEASURES

Dasu HPP management believes in satisfaction of stakeholders on one hand and building working and rational relationship with them on the other hand. DHPP initiate different activities from time to time to build the confidence of the local community in line with the guidelines enunciated in different Social & Resettlement Plans (SRMPs). Therefore, to achieve this end, G & CH section has conducted 3 free medical camps, Solar system installed at RHC Dasu and basic health facility established by the contractor at Dasu. Similarly, distribution of food items during heavy rains and school bags distribution as well as school vans provision to schools have also been initiated by DHPP. Likewise, the communication & PR section has been able to conduct two exposure visits for school teachers and students to Tarbela Dam Project so that they could be able to see, observe and gain the basic information about Dam construction, its working, advantages and more importantly its social and economical impacts in the area and they could be able to share their observation and information back at home inside the community. It is believed that such activities will promote better relations among the stakeholders in the better interest of the project.
